ADMISSIONS PROCESS

We have an integrated and experienced admissions team available to assess and guide individuals to clinically and financially aligned services. Our team connects callers to our diversified services at Lifeskills or to our external, trusted clinical provider network.

- 1. To begin the admissions process, the client, their family member, or an engaged clinical provider, calls Lifeskills to provide clinical and financial information to determine eligibility. At this time, medical records will be requested.
- 2. Based on appropriateness, a phone assessment with the client, or designee, is scheduled.
- **3.** If it is determined that Lifeskills is the right clinical and financial fit, an admissions date will be secured.
- **4.** If Lifeskills is not found to be the appropriate placement, we will provide referrals to high-quality, trusted providers aligned with the clinical and financial requirements needed.
